Milford Sound is often described as the eighth wonder of the world. Set in the Fiordland National Park on the West Coast of the South Island, it provides the most dramatic backdrop of scenery in New Zealand.

On this exclusive product you will see the best of what Milford Sound has to offer.

Fly to Milford

Fly from Queenstown airport over the Wakatipu Basin and the Shotover River heading towards Glenorchy and the head of Lake Wakatipu. Fly past the famous Earnslaw Burn Glacier and over Lake McKerrow taking in the grandeur of the Southern Alps, flying deep into the heart of Fiordland National Park. View the glaciated region of Fiordland's tallest mountain, Mt Tutuko, and sweep the length of Milford Sound where you can take in unparalleled views of world famous Milford Sound and Mitre Peak before landing at Milford Sound airport.

Milford Track Walk

Upon landing at Milford Sound you will meet your private guide for the day and take a short boat ride from Deepwater Basin to Sandfly Point to begin your walk on the Milford Track. We begin our guided walk, meandering alongside the cascading Arthur River then Lake Ada, on a well formed track. Our destination and half way point is Giants Gate waterfall. This spectacular waterfall is best viewed and photographed from the large swing bridge spanning the river and, on completion of the walk, an opportunity is made for photos at the sign marking the end of the walk, festooned with the boots of walkers that have made it to the end of the walk. After your transfer back to Deepwater Basin board your Mitre Peak cruise for a two hour cruise on Milford Sound.

Cruise on Milford

Mitre Peak Cruises offers regular two-hour trips traversing the deep waters of Milford Sound. The only cruise option that always goes past St Anne's Lighthouse, and out into the Tasman Sea, a Mitre Peak Cruise gives our guests a chance to enter Milford Sound from the outside, approaching it just as the first sealers did at the end of the 18th century. Your informative guide will point out scenic highlights along the way, such as the Bowen Falls (dropping 160 metres seaward), Sinbad Gully (a classic example of a hanging valley), snow-capped Mount Pembroke, and the awe-inspiring Mitre Peak itself, towering 1692 metres from the ocean floor.

Fly back to Queenstown

After your cruise on Milford Sound, board your plane to view the Milford Track from above before having your breath taken away when you first view the 548 metre Sutherland Falls. This scenic flight will allow you to take in magnificent views of the mountains, glaciers, lakes and forests of the Fiordland national Park on your way back to Queenstown.
